

Harrington PDA
Minutes
February 17, 2009

The Harrington PDA meeting was called to order by President Wanda Buddrius on Feb. 17, 2009 at 5:10pm at the City Hall. Those present were: Cassandra Pfaffle-Dick, Bunny Haugan, Billie Herron, Wanda and Pam Kelly from the EDC.

The PDA is interested in cultural enhancement and forming a Historical District that we all work together to accomplish through the formation of a Certified Local Government (CLG). Geoff Talkington will be invited to attend as he has a historic building that he is interested in adding to the historic district.
