

## **Harrington PDA Minutes for 3/3/08**

Pam Kelley gave an update on the following items:

- 2) Pam contacted Career Connections and confirmed they are closing.

- 4) Negotiations are underway on the purchase of land near Sprague for the NASCAR facility.

### **ATV – DUAL SPORTS EVENTS**

Ron Costlow and Ed from Odessa were present to share ideas and give information regarding the possibility of connecting primitive roads in Lincoln County that could result in trails for bikers to use and events that could attract these folks to the various small communities in the County. Dual sports would require paved or hard surface roads. Each community would be responsible for the maps and signage defining the routes and brochures that could be sent to the various clubs that would be interested in participating. Ted offered to do an area map with trails marked.

Also discussed was the idea that the golf club in Odessa and the one in Harrington might brainstorm some dual activities.
