OLD BUSINESS:

Inland Empire Oilseed: Mark DeWulf updated the Board on the Lease change and Forbearance Agreement. All parties have signed the documents and Mark is waiting to get all of the signed copies back. He will then forward to WSDA.

Barr Bio-Industrial Park: Lease is in progress with attorneys. Barr Tech will be contracting with Fogle Pump to drill the well. The land has not been transferred to OPDA and the well is needed to receive the septic permit, which is a requirement of CERB. The OPDA has sent a letter to Fogle Drill & Pump notifying them we will not be proceeding with the well drilling. Barr Tech has received their letter of credit.

NEW BUSINESS:

Barr Bio-Industrial Park: The board discussed a partial repayment of the \$83,600 loan received from Barr Tech.

Action: Kim Ramm moved and Mike Edens seconded a motion to repay Barr Tech \$15,000 of the \$83,600 loan made to the OPDA. Motion carried. 4 – 0

The Board received Task Order #5 from CH2MHill. Task Order #5 covers Erosion and Sediment Control Inspection, required by the Dept. of Ecology. Total amount budgeted is \$2975.00.

Action: Steven Powell moved and George Rodeck seconded a motion to authorize Steven Powell to sign Task Order #5 from CH2MHill. Motion carried. 3– 1.
