

Harrington School Swimming Pool Open to Public

The Office of the Superintendent of Harrington Schools, and the Harrington School Board, have decided to make the school's indoor swimming pool available for public swimming during winter months. The pool is the only indoor pool in Lincoln County.

At present, the pool is open to the public on Monday and Thursday nights, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.. Typically, the first hour is dedicated to "open" or "family" swimming, and the second hour usually is reserved for lap swimming, depending on the number of swimmers in attendance. If sufficient interest is expressed by the public for swimming on weekends, Saturday hours may be added to the winter schedule.

Admission is \$1.50 per person, which includes use of the on-site men's and women's locker rooms, with hot showers. Lifeguards are on duty at the pool.

The pool can be reserved for swimming parties, or other training activities, by pre-arrangement. An hourly fee is applied for parties, depending on the size of the group.

Entrance to the pool is through the double doors on the west side of the building, under the covered walkway.

A lifeguard training course may be offered again during the spring, if there is sufficient interest.
